Project overview

School Infrastructure NSW is building a new multipurpose hall at Engadine High School. The hall will include a full basketball court, stage, amenities, and sports and performance storage.

Progress summary

As you may be aware from our last project update, Lloyd Group who were engaged by the Department of Education to deliver Engadine High School Hall, went into administration in March 2023 halting all construction.

We are pleased to announce Stephen Edwards Constructions has been appointed as the builder to complete the remaining construction of the Engadine High School upgrade.

Next steps

With the new builder on board, a detailed works program will be finalised, and they will begin to reestablish the site in the coming weeks and prepare to restart construction.

We are expecting to complete the remaining works to finalise the new multipurpose hall by mid-2024, subject to weather conditions. An exact date for completion and handover will be shared with the community once more information becomes available.
