## Investing in our schools

As part of the NSW Government's plan to rebuild essential services, the 2023-24 Budget is delivering a record \$8.8 billion for new and upgraded schools. This targeted investment in growing communities will ensure working families get access to a world class public education.

## Project summary

A project is underway to build a new multipurpose hall at Engadine High School. The hall will include a multi-use sports court, stage, amenities, and storage for sports and performances.

The project team have worked through the issues and impacts resulting from the previous builder going into administration in 2023 and the project is on track for completion in mid-2024.

## Progress update

Construction of the new hall is progressed well. The roof and external façade are complete and the building is watertight. The mains power connection for the school has been relocated to Birok Avenue and power is now connected.

Internal works are also progressing well with lights, fans, heaters, AV equipment, bathrooms and timber sports flooring nearing completion.

## Next steps

Final painting, finishes for bathrooms and stairs, and the commissioning of electrical systems will be completed internally over the coming weeks.

External works will be ongoing including stairs, handrails and balustrades, concrete pathways and retaining walls. This will be closely followed by landscaping works.
