Project update | October 2021

The NSW Government is investing \$7.9 billion over the next four years, continuing its program to deliver 215 new and upgraded schools to support communities across NSW. This is the largest investment in public education infrastructure in the history of NSW.

The NSW Department of Education is committed to delivering new and upgraded schools for communities across NSW. The delivery of these important projects is essential to the future learning needs of our students and supports growth in the local economy.

Project overview

An upgrade is underway for a new multi-purpose hall at Engadine High School. The hall will include a full basketball court, stage, amenities, and sports and performance storage.

Progress

- The Development Application (DA) for the new hall at Engadine High School has been approved by the South Sydney Planning Panel and Sutherland Shire Council.
- Bonded asbestos fragments were removed from the Modular Demountable Room (MDR) site by licensed and accredited asbestos contractors. A clearance certificate has been issued to confirm the area is safe for staff and students.
- Lloyd Group is now replacing the current dance/band rooms with two new MDR buildings.

Next steps

Once the current dance/band rooms have been replaced, Lloyd Group will install fencing and site sheds before starting main works in late October/early November.

School Infrastructure NSW (SINSW) will work closely with the school leadership team to ensure continuity of school operations and to minimise any potential impact on student learning during construction. SINSW will also continue to prepare notifications to neighbouring properties to keep them informed of the impact of school construction on the local area.
