Project update

Investing in our schools

The NSW Government is investing \$6.7 billion over four years to deliver more than 190 new and upgraded schools to support communities across NSW. In addition, a record \$1.3 billion is being spent on school maintenance over five years. This is the largest investment in public education infrastructure in the history of NSW.

Epping Public School upgrade

A project is underway to upgrade Epping Public School. The project will deliver:

- 22 new permanent teaching spaces
- a new library
- an upgrade of existing core facilities, including special programs rooms
- an upgrade of existing administration and staff areas.

Progress summary

The Epping Public School upgrade will be completed in two stages. Stage 1 has been completed, which delivered 22 new permanent teaching spaces and a new library at the start of the 2020 school year.

Stage 2 of the project is underway for the refurbishment of the administration building.

Next steps

Work will continue over coming weeks on the internal refurbishment and fit out of the administration building.

February 2020

Traffic management will be in place as needed to ensure the safety of pedestrians and vehicles.

Stage 2 is on track to be completed by the start of Term 2, 2020.

We will continue to work with the school community and neighbours to ensure that disruptions are minimised.
