Investing in our schools

The NSW Government's 2018/19 Budget includes \$6 billion over four years to deliver more than 170 new and upgraded schools. A further \$160 million has also been invested as part of the record \$747 million maintenance investment announced last year. This is the largest investment in public education infrastructure in the history of NSW.

Epping Public School project

A project is underway to upgrade Epping Public School. The project will deliver:

- 22 new permanent teaching spaces
- a new library
- an upgrade of existing core facilities, including special programs rooms and administration.

Progress summary

The school upgrade is underway with demolition and site clearance works completed.

The foundations of the new building are in place.

Next steps

Works on the new building will continue with the establishment of the ground floor slab.

Working closely with the School Principal, teachers and staff, the design and construct contractor will finalise furniture selection and the design to upgrade the existing administration facilities.
