Investing in our schools

The NSW Government is investing \$6.7 billion over the next four years to deliver 190 new and upgraded schools to support communities across NSW. In addition, a record \$1.3 billion is being spent on school maintenance over five years. This is the largest investment in public education infrastructure in the history of NSW.

Project overview

A project is underway to deliver a new primary school for Wagga Wagga. This school will include:

- Flexible learning spaces to facilitate new ways of teaching and learning
- Administration and staff facilities
- A library, hall, canteen and covered outdoor learning area (COLA)

The site for the new school will be integrated with the Charles Sturt University campus in Estella.

Progress and next steps

Planning is well underway on the new primary school with the concept design completed.

School Infrastructure NSW has lodged documents for the State Significant Development planning process, including an Environment Impact Statement and technical studies with the Department of Planning, Industry and Environment (DPIE). From mid November, DPIE will publicly exhibit these documents for 28 days on their website – https:// www.planningportal.nsw.gov.au/major-projects.
