#### Investing in our schools

The NSW Government is investing \$6.7 billion over the next four years to deliver 190 new and upgraded schools to support communities across NSW. In addition, a record \$1.3 billion is being spent on school maintenance over five years. This is the largest investment in public education infrastructure in the history of NSW.

#### **Excelsior Public School**

An upgrade is underway at Excelsior Public School. The project will include:

- 14 new teaching spaces
- a new three-storey building
- additional administration area
- new library and new school entrance.

#### **Progress summary**

The upgrade to Excelsior Public School is progressing well with the new administration building and Block A refurbishment now complete. The new three storey building, Block L, will house a new library, canteen and learning spaces, and is nearing completion.

## The project is expected to be completed mid-2020.

#### Summer school holiday works

Over the summer holidays work will continue on the new three storey building.

Internal finishes and fixtures will be fitted and finished, walls will be painted and flooring will be laid and finished.

Paving and soft landscaping work will also take place over this break.

Safety testing of the building will also take place and final site cleaning.

Works will take place on site on the following business days:

- 21, 27, 28, 30 and 31 December 2019
- 2, 3 and 4 January 2020.

### Frequently asked questions

#### What are the construction working hours?

Construction hours over the summer school holidays will be:

- Monday to Friday from 7:00am to 5:00pm
- Saturday from 7:00am to 1:00pm

No work will take place on Sundays and public holidays.

# Will construction take place over Christmas and New Year?

Yes, as outlined above, however no works will take place on Sundays or public holidays.

#### What safety measures will be in place?

The health and safety of the community is our highest priority. Temporary fencing will be erected around the construction site to secure the area.

## What steps will be taken to control noise and dust impacts?

Noise and dust control measures will be implemented in accordance with planning approval requirements.

Hoarding and shade cloth have been erected to reduce noise and dust impacts on the school and local residents. Dust from construction works will be hosed down as required.

#### How will traffic be managed?

Traffic management will be in place where required for the safety of students, staff, the local community and workers.

Traffic controllers will be used where required to manage entry and exit of vehicles to and from the construction site. Vehicles will give way to pedestrians at all times.
