

Excelsior Public School Project Update

September 2018

Investing in our schools

The NSW Government is spending \$6 billion over four years to deliver more than 170 new and upgraded schools. This includes an additional \$160 million in 2018/19 as part of the record \$747 million maintenance investment announced last year. This is the biggest investment in public school infrastructure in the history of NSW.

Excelsior Public School upgrade

An upgrade is being planned for Excelsior Public School to deliver new facilities and futurefocused learning spaces to accomodate 650 students. The project will deliver:

- 14 new future-focused learning spaces
- a new three storey building
- additional administration area
- a new library and new school entrance.

Progress summary

To minimise disruption to students and learning, the project is being delivered in phases with the relocation of demountables completed.

The design for the school upgrade has been finalised and the construction works contract will be awarded soon.

Next steps

A construction site will be established within the school grounds and safety fencing will be used to separate students from the construction area.

Construction of the new building is planned to start October 2018 with learning spaces and facilities expected to be completed late 2020.

Deliveries will be scheduled for outside school drop off and pick-up times, and traffic controllers will be on-site to assist with contractor deliveries.

School Infrastructure NSW is working closely with the Principal and staff to reduce disruption to students and learning as much as possible. Regular project updates will be sent to the school community.
