#### Investing in our schools

The NSW Government is investing \$6.7 billion over four years to deliver more than 190 new and upgraded schools to support communities across NSW. In addition, a record \$1.3 billion is being spent on school maintenance over five years. This is the largest investment in public education infrastructure in the history of NSW.

The NSW Department of Education is committed to delivering new and upgraded schools for communities across New South Wales. The delivery of these important projects is essential to the future learning needs of our students and supports growth in the local economy.

#### Fairvale High School

A project is underway to upgrade Fairvale High School. The project will increase the school's capacity and includes:

- 30 permanent teaching spaces including specialised classrooms for science, technology and food technology
- New multipurpose hall including gym facilities, stage and canteen
- Improved outdoor play space, including a new covered outdoor learning area (COLA)
- New and expanded staff administration facilities
- Demolition of the Bini Dome
- Associated landscaping.

#### **Progress summary**

The Contractor has completed site establishment and the construction works have commenced.

### Term 1 holiday works

Works will continue at Fairvale High School over the Term 1 school holidays. Work will be focused on inground services and earthworks for the new covered outdoor learning area.

Work hours are 7:00am to 6:00pm Monday to Friday and 8:00am to 1:00pm on Saturdays. No work will take place on Sundays or public holidays.

In line with the NSW Environmental Planning and Assessment (COVID-19 Development – Construction Work Days) Order 2020, School Infrastructure NSW construction sites can now operate on weekends and public holidays during the COVID-19 pandemic. This is to allow workers to abide by social distancing rules while on construction sites by distributing building work across the week.

We will determine whether there is a need to adopt the new rule and notify you of any changes to standard construction hours and will ensure work is considerate of neighbours with noise kept to a minimum.
