#### Investing in our schools

#### **Progress summary**

Structural work and roof sheeting has been completed for the new outdoor learning space with the concrete slab being formed up for installation. The existing building Block C has been demolished making space for the new Block K building. The installation of the onsite detention tank is also in progress.

#### School holiday works

Over the break, we will be:

- connecting the onsite detention tank (OSD) to the existing stormwater system
- completing the concrete slab for the new outdoor learning space

• carry out footings and piling works for the new Block K building.

#### What are the construction working hours?

Construction hours over the Term 2 holiday will be as per the existing approved hours. 7:00am to 6:00pm Monday to Friday and 8:00am to 1:00pm on Saturdays. No work will take place on Sundays.

#### What safety measures will be in place?

The health and safety of the community is our highest priority. Site fencing has been erected around the construction site to secure the area and prevent public access / school access.

# What steps will be taken to control noise and dust impacts?

Noise and dust control measures will be implemented in accordance with planning approval requirements. Temporary fencing with shade cloth has been erected to reduce dust impacts on the school. The site, dust from construction works and trucks will be regularly hosed down as required, to minimise dust, pending water-use restrictions.
