Project update

Investing in our schools

The NSW Government is investing \$6.7 billion over four years to deliver more than 190 new and upgraded schools to support communities across NSW. In addition, a record \$1.3 billion is being spent on school maintenance over five years. This is the largest investment in public education infrastructure in the history of NSW.

Fairvale High School

A project is underway to upgrade Fairvale High School. The project will increase the school's capacity and includes:

- 30 permanent teaching areas including science, technology, food tech and other specialised classroom spaces
- New multipurpose hall
- New double basketball courts with covered outdoor learning area (COLA)
- Demolition of Bini Dome
- Removal of demountable buildings
- Associated landscaping

Progress summary

The contract for main works was awarded to Cockram Constructions on 8 January 2020.

Next steps

Site establishment will commence to prepare the construction area ahead of works starting. As part of this, Cockram Constructions will:

- install the site office and work sheds; and
- deliver equipment.

In addition, the detailed design and the State Significant Development Application pre-commencement conditions will be completed.
