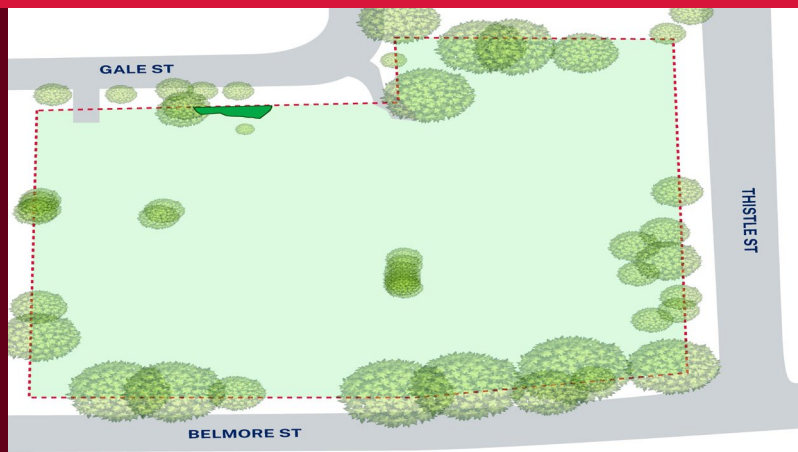


Former Meadowbank Public School Conversion to Open Space

Project overview

As part of the NSW Government's plan to rebuild essential services, a project is underway to redevelop the former Meadowbank Public School site into a new public open space. This project will provide residents and visitors with more access to quality green recreational outdoor areas.

Progress summary

Demolition of the main buildings on the site is well underway. Most of the buildings have now been demolished and debris removed.

A development application (DA) has been submitted to City of Ryde Council to change the use of the site from a school to recreation. The DA is different to the planning proposal to rezone, however, it is connected and will allow us to use the site as a recreation facility.

Next steps

- Remove 2 concrete slabs and a retaining wall.
- Landscaping works to lay turf and mulch once the site is cleared.
- Continue to engage with City of Ryde Council.

The project is anticipated to be finished by mid 2025.
