Works notification | 30 March 2023

Closure of temporary shared pathway from Wednesday 29 March 2023

The temporary shared pathway to the east of the Fort Street Public School site will be closed from Wednesday 29 March 2023 for road widening works on Upper Fort Street adjacent to the school site. These works will include the removal of the Bradfield Shed (a Transport for NSW asset) as well as creating new permanent public access for pedestrians and cyclists.

A diversion will be in place for pedestrians and cyclists until August 2023, when the new permanent public access is opened. See map of the diversion routes over leaf.

The pedestrian diversion through Observatory Hill is via Agar Street Steps with cyclist diversion via Watson Road, Argyle Street and Kent Street. The National Trust is private property and not open for public access.

Cyclists must adhere to signage and road use guidelines including speed limits. Cyclists must use the road diversion via Watson Road and Kent St, cycling on the footpath is not permitted.

Traffic controllers and signage will be on site to guide and assist pedestrians. Emergency vehicles will have priority at all times and will not be impacted by the works.
