Investing in our schools

The NSW Government is investing \$6.7 billion over the next four years to deliver 190 new and upgraded schools to support communities across NSW. In addition, a record \$1.3 billion is being spent on school maintenance over five years. This is the largest investment in public education infrastructure in the history of NSW.

Fort Street Public School

Early planning is underway to redevelop Fort Street Public School to cater for projected enrolment growth in the area and to provide students with additional educational facilities that inspire growth, build capability and practical skills that last a lifetime.

The project proposes to deliver new flexible learning spaces in existing and new buildings as well as upgrades to core facilities and site improvements, including access and play space. This also includes providing facilities for the Department of Education's Observatory Hill Environmental Education Centre, which has historically shared the site.

Project summary

The project is in the early planning stage. The scope and design are being developed to accommodate the projected growth of the school population and to respect the heritage characteristics of the site and the broader Observatory Hill.

At this stage, we are also investigating construction phase options and how the school's operations can best be maintained during the construction period. This includes consideration of temporary off-site options as the health, safety and well-being of the teachers, staff and students is our highest priority.
