

Fort Street Public School

Works notification

April 2021

A project is underway to upgrade Fort Street Public School to cater to growing enrolments and provide exciting new spaces for learning and teaching. The upgrade includes a range of new and refurbished buildings, which will be sensitive to the area's character and heritage.

Sydney Harbour Bridge southern cycleway works

In response to community feedback on the proposed temporary diversion of the Sydney Harbour Bridge cycleway along Kent Street, we are maintaining the existing cycleway along Upper Fort Street for the duration of construction works for the Fort Street Public School upgrade. To ensure the cycleway can operate safely while the school upgrade works are underway, we need to make a minor realignment of the cycleway alongside the Fort Street Public School. The existing cycleway will remain open while these minor works are underway. More detail about these works is provided below.

Upcoming works

From 4 May 2021, we will be undertaking minor works to realign the cycleway so that it can operate safely while construction works are underway. The work is expected to take up to four weeks to complete, weather permitting, and will involve:

- Establishing a safe work area
- Installing a two-way section of the cycleway alongside Bradfield Highway
- Removing three small trees
- Removing one parking metre and one parking sign
- Putting up fencing (hoarding) to separate the realigned cycleway from the construction site.

Work hours

The realignment work will take place between 7:00am and 6:00pm, Monday to Friday and 8:00am to 1:00pm on Saturdays.

Changes to cycle and pedestrian conditions

While the realignment work is underway, traffic controllers and signage will be in place to ensure the safety of bike riders and pedestrians. Temporary short duration closures may be required from time to time, but will be managed with priority given to bike riders and pedestrians. If you travel along this route, please slow down and follow signage and direction of traffic controls.
