Investing in our schools

As part of the NSW Government's plan to rebuild essential services, the 2023-24 Budget is delivering a record \$8.8 billion for new and upgraded schools. This targeted investment in growing communities will ensure working families get access to a world class public education.

Project overview

The Green Square Public School and Community Spaces is being delivered by the NSW Government in partnership with the City of Sydney. It will provide new classrooms and core facilities to meet local enrolment demand as well as a range of spaces for community use.

The school is being built on the former Royal South Sydney Hospital site on Joynton Avenue. This project will deliver flexible classrooms, a library and canteen, staff rooms, administrative offices and amenities, a covered outdoor learning area (COLA), multipurpose spaces (community and shared spaces), Out of School Hours care (OOSH), a games court and adjacent courtyard (shared spaces).

Green Square New Principal Appointment

We're excited to announce that a new Principal, Nicole Molloy, has been appointed to the school. With 28 years of experience as a dedicated public educator, Nicole has served as a principal for the past 14 years. Green Square Public School opening

The Green Square Public School will officially open on Day 1 of Term 1, 2025, with students and staff temporarily located at the Rainbow Street Public School, at 90 Rainbow St, Randwick, before moving to their new permanent location later in 2025.

The school will provide bus transport to and from the Green Square Public School to Rainbow Street Public School in the mornings and afternoons until the new site is ready.

Transition to the new school building will occur once construction is completed, with the specific date to be announced closer to completion in 2025. The Department of Education and the City of Sydney are working closely, together with the construction contractor, to deliver this new school as quickly as possible.



Enrolment plans for Green Square Public School

Enrolments for 2025 will be limited to Kindergarten, Year 1, and Year 2, with Kindergarten to Year 4 students able to enrol in 2026 and Kindergarten to Year 6 in 2027.
