

Green Square Public School – including information about community spaces



Works notification | February 2022

A project is underway to deliver a new primary school and community spaces in Green Square. The project is jointly funded by the Department of Education and the City of Sydney and includes fit-for-purpose learning spaces and core facilities to meet enrolment demands in the area. It also includes a number of community and shared spaces, including multipurpose spaces, a games court and adjacent courtyard, and a community hall.

Dear Parents and Carers,

This notification provides an update on the works next door for a new primary school and community spaces in Green Square. As previously notified early works, including demolition of the hydrotherapy pool building, started in November 2021 and is anticipated to finish in February 2022.

The early works includes two phases:

Phase 1: Heavy structural demolition

These works took place during the Waranara Early Education Centre (WEEC) shutdown period to minimise disruption to the centre. During this phase, scaffolding was installed around the building facades facing WEEC while large excavators demolished the building. This work is now finished.

Phase 2: Removal of construction material from site

These works will take place between 7 February and 28 February 2022, weather dependent. Demolished material will be broken down by excavators on site, loaded onto trucks and removed from site. The existing carpark and pavements will also be removed.

During Phase 2 works, excavators will be used on site to reduce the size of the construction material. This work will take place during the approved Development Approval (DA) hours of 7.30 am to 5.30 pm Monday to Friday, and 7.30 am to 3.30 pm on Saturdays. Noise and vibration monitoring will be undertaken to ensure the noise levels do not exceed safe levels, in compliance with the DA.

Traffic control measures will be in place to assist with traffic movement where necessary. Vehicle barriers and hoarding has been installed between the construction site and the WEEC boundary as an additional safety measure.

Dust control measures will be used to reduce dust impacts on WEEC. Stock piles will be soaked with water overnight to reduce dust particles while loading trucks. If required, water cannons will be used to further suppress dust.
