

Green Square Public School – including information about community spaces

Works notification | 11 October 2021



Dear Neighbour,

As part of the planning process for the new primary school and community spaces at Green Square, an archaeological investigation will start from 18 October 2021.

The investigation is part of the planning process and will be included in the Environmental Impact Statement that is being prepared for the State Significant Development application for this project.

Specifically, the archaeological investigation is for an Aboriginal Heritage Impact Permit. The investigation will involve digging and refilling approximately 12 small test pits across the project site. The test pits will be dug by a team of archaeologists with monitoring by representatives of the local Aboriginal community.

This excavation work will take up to seven days, but it may take longer if any objects of interest are found. Work will take place between 7:30 am and 4:30 pm, Monday to Friday. Where possible pits will be dug by hand using shovels, however in some cases excavating machinery may need to be used for short periods of time.

We will work closely with the Waranara Early Education Centre management to minimise disruption to their operations. There will be no change to vehicle or pedestrian access as a result of the work.

The health, safety, and well-being of the local community is our highest priority and we will continue to keep the community updated.

All excavation work will be conducted in accordance with current NSW Covid-19 protocols. We apologise for any inconvenience during this essential work.
