#### Investing in our schools

The NSW Government is investing \$8.6 billion in school infrastructure over the next four years, continuing its program to deliver 160 new and upgraded schools to support communities across NSW. This builds on the more than \$9.1 billion invested in projects delivered since 2017, a program of \$17.7 billion in public education infrastructure.

The NSW Department of Education is committed to delivering new and upgraded schools for communities across NSW. The delivery of these important projects is essential to the future learning needs of our students and supports growth in the local economy.

#### Stage 2 for Galungara Public School

Construction on Stage 2 of the Galungara Public School began in March 2022. The school was planned and designed to be constructed in stages. Stage 2 is now progressing and will provide additional capacity to meet the need of the growing local community. Stage 2 includes:

- 20 new learning spaces
- two additional covered outdoor learning areas
- two new multipurpose games courts
- landscaping works.

#### **Progress summary**

Work continues on Block B3 and Block B4, with the roof structure on both buildings now completed, and the roof sheeting being installed. The façade framing installation has started, and the structural steel installation has also commenced. Block B3 will have 8 learning spaces and Block B4 will have 12 learning spaces. The concrete for the Block B2-B3 link bridge has also been poured.

#### Next steps

Works for Stage 2 will continue with the installation of the building envelope and façade. This is the next major milestone in achieving water-tightness, meaning that the building is now rain-proof.

Internal works will also continue including fit out works. This includes internal walls and high level services (electrical, mechanical, plumbing and communications) rough-in throughout the building.
