Frequently asked questions

How many students will be at Galungara Public School for Day 1 Term 1 2023?

720 students are expected to be at Galungara Public School for Day 1 Term 1 2023.

What changes are being made to ensure greater pedestrian access to Galungara Public School?

The pedestrian crossing on Farmland Drive is being relocated, along with a pedestrian crossing and refuge on Jerralong Drive. There will also be additional traffic signage on Farmland Drive, including a no stopping zone.

Will there be additional bus services for the school?

To better support students travelling to school, there will be an additional bus service for Term 1 and Term 2.

Will parking continue to be available in the joint use carpark?

Parking for staff and visitors will continue in the joint use carpark. This includes for the kiss and drop area, mobility parking and parent parking during school hours. Refer to the enclosed map for details.
