Investing in our schools

As part of the NSW Government's plan to rebuild essential services, the 2023-24 Budget is delivering a record \$3.5 billion for new and upgraded schools in Western Sydney. This targeted investment in growing communities will ensure working families get access to a world class public education.

Stage 2 of Galungara Public School is supporting the increasing population of the North West Growth Area.

Project overview

On Day 1 Term 1 2023, as part of stage 2, we opened an additional 20 learning spaces and a covered outdoor learning area (COLA). Work is continuing to deliver a games court and landscaping.

Progress update

In the September/October school holidays, the contractor completed public domain works on Farmland Drive including building permanent pedestrian traffic islands, and a pedestrian refuge island on Jerralong Drive.

Next steps

Street lighting on Farmland Drive will be erected soon, and we will notify the community in advance of this work.

Pelican Road is awaiting dedication as a public road by the Blacktown City Council. Once this is finalised, the contractor will be able to access the area needed to build the school sports courts and complete construction of a bus bay on Pelican Road and footpaths on Farmland Drive.
