






# Gillieston Public School redevelopment

As part of the NSW Government’s plan to rebuild public education, the 2024-25 Budget is delivering record education funding, including \$8.9 billion for new and upgraded schools. This targeted investment will ensure growing communities get access to a world class public education. A project is underway to redevelop Gillieston Public School by replacing the demountables on the existing site with modern classrooms and ancillary spaces. The new building will include:

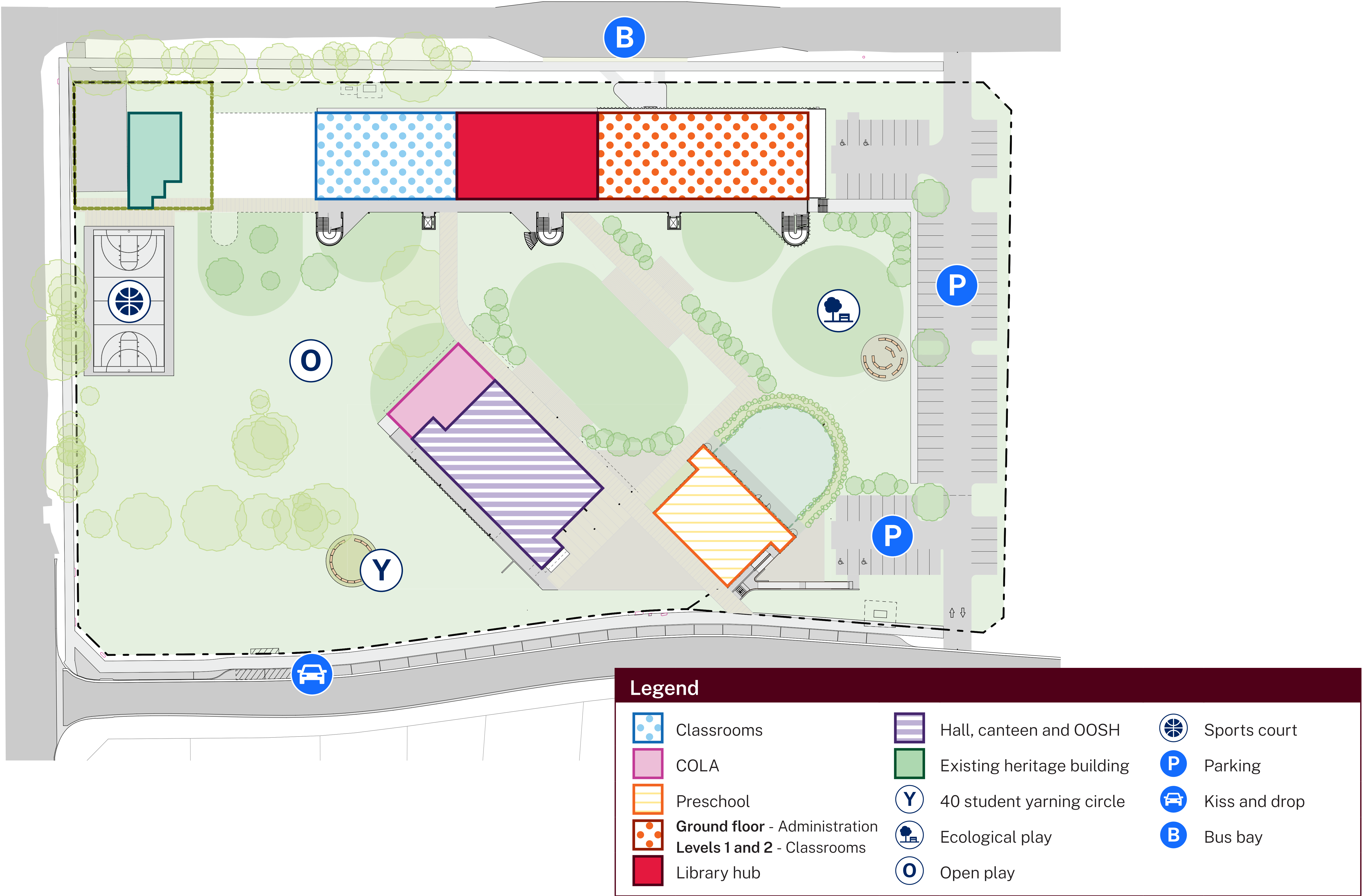


# Concept site plan

Construction will be coordinated to ensure the current school remains operational and enable teaching and learning to continue onsite.

A new public preschool will also be provided at the school as part of the NSW Government commitment to expand access to early childhood education. The preschool will be separated from the primary school areas and will have its own entry, parking and secure outdoor area with play equipment.

The Gillieston Public School upgrade is being delivered in stages to minimise the impact on the school community and ensure students have maximum access to school facilities at all times throughout the upgrade.

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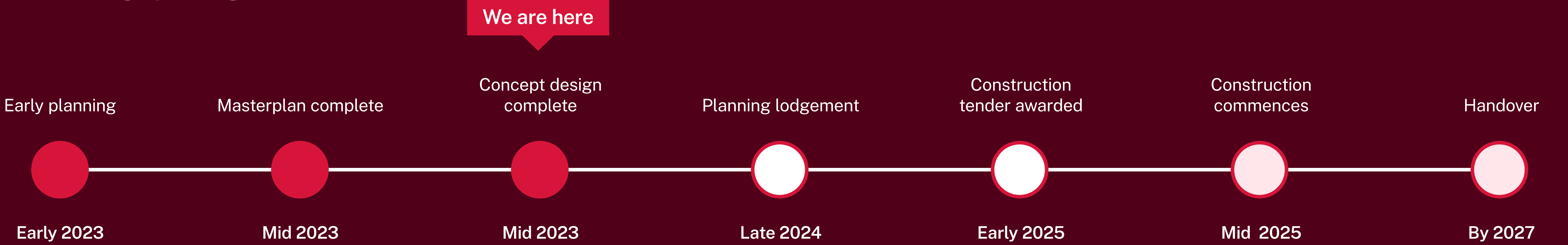

As part of our reporting requirements, we are preparing a Social Impact Assessment (SIA) for the proposed upgrade of Gillieston Public School.

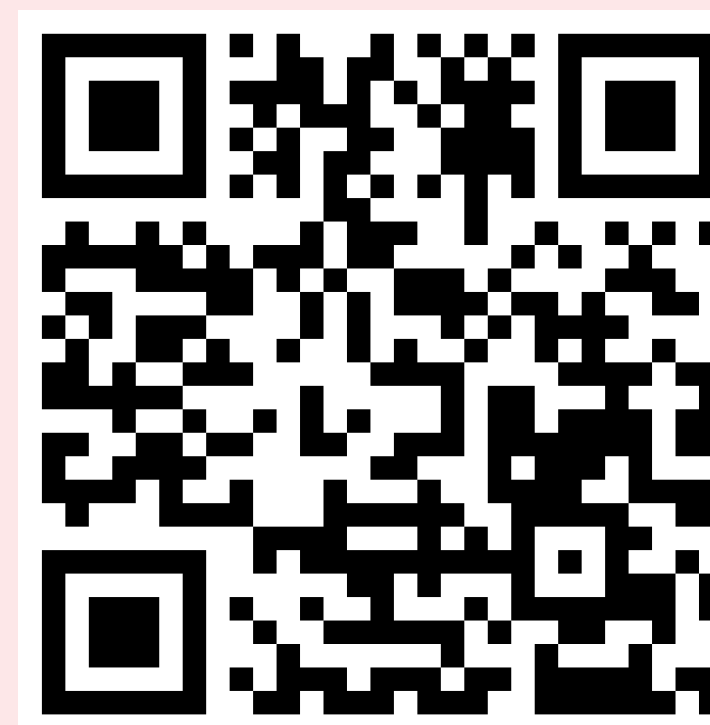
