Investing in our schools

As part of the NSW Government's plan to rebuild public education, the 2024-25 Budget is delivering record education funding, including \$3.6 billion for new and upgraded schools in Western Sydney. This targeted investment will ensure growing communities get access to a world class public education.

Project overview

Work is underway for a new high school for Gledswood Hills and Gregory Hills. In the short term, a purpose built temporary high school will cater for Year 7 students in 2025. It will be located alongside Gregory Hills Public School.

The temporary high school will accommodate up to 150 Year 7 students in 2025 and up to 300 students in 2026 (accommodating Year 7 and 8 students) and will include:

- general classrooms
- specialist classrooms for science, wood and multipurpose workshops, food technology, music and visual arts
- a library and administration facilities
- dedicated toilets and change rooms.

The permanent high school is due to open Day 1 Term 1 2027 and will include:

- new permanent modern classrooms
- specialist support classrooms
- a multipurpose hall for sports and performance, sports and recreation facilities
- a covered outdoor learning area (COLA), a library, canteen and administration facilities.

Progress update permanent site

We are pleased to confirm the construction tender for the permanent high school has been released. The contractor, once appointed, will advance the design of the new buildings to prepare for construction, which will start once the planning approval is received.

- Complete the tender process and award the construction contract. When the contractor has been appointed, we will establish the timeline for the new school build and share it with the school community.
- Progressing the statutory planning process for the permanent high school. A planning application will be prepared, which will be supported by a range of specialist reports. We will notify the community when the application is placed on public exhibition at which time the reports will be available to view.
