Gledswood Hills Public School Stage 2

Project update | December 2023

Project overview

As part of the NSW Government's plan to rebuild essential services, the 2023-24 Budget is delivering a record \$3.5 billion for new and upgraded schools in Western Sydney. This targeted investment in growing communities will ensure working families get access to a world class public education.

The upgrade of Gledswood Hills Public School will deliver 20 new flexible classrooms and an extension to the existing car park.

The upgrade is expected to be complete by mid-2024.

Progress summary

Both Buildings F and G have reached their full height, and installation of the roof to both buildings is underway.

Rough in of electrical and plumbing works is complete and sheeting of internal walls and external brickwork is now taking place with services fit-off and sheeting.

Next steps

During the remainder of Term 4 we will focus on making sure the buildings are watertight. This involves finishing the external facade of the building, completing the brickwork, installing the glazing and doors, and installation of the roof including solar panels.

We are aiming to remove scaffolding around both buildings over the summer school holidays. Scaffold removal will be completed prior to students returning to school in 2024, weather permitting.

Throughout the summer break we are anticipating completion of the external part of the buildings with internal works commencing into early next year.

There will be no work taking place from 22 December 2023 to 3 January 2024 due to the Christmas and New Year's holiday period. Work will recommence Wednesday 3 January 2024. Working hours will continue to be 7 am to 6 pm Monday to Friday and 8 am to 1 pm Saturday.

School Infrastructure NSW will be closed from 5 pm Friday 22 December 2023 to 9 am Monday 8 January 2024 inclusive, in line with the NSW Government shut down period. During this time if or there is an urgent issue please contact the site manager listed on the construction site entry. In an emergency please call triple zero (000).

Frequently Asked Questions

What are the scheduled working hours?

Work will take place from 7 am to 6 pm from Monday to Friday and from 8 am to 1 pm on Saturday.

What safety measures are in place?

The safety of the school's students, staff and the local community is our highest priority. Construction planning has been designed so there is minimal impact on school operations. Traffic control personnel are on site to assist with contractor deliveries. Buffer zones will be in place for large machinery and where possible, works near the temporary school will be scheduled outside of school operation hours.

What steps are being taken to control noise and dust impacts?

All work onsite will be conducted in accordance with NSW Government noise, safety, environmental, and building regulations. We are working closely with the school Principal to minimise impacts to staff, teachers, students, and neighbours.

How is traffic managed?

Construction vehicle movements and deliveries will be scheduled outside of peak school operation times. Traffic management will be in place where required to manage vehicles entering and exiting the site in a safe manner. Site deliveries will be scheduled outside of school drop off and pick up times (where possible) and traffic control personnel will be on site to assist with deliveries and traffic movement.

How do you minimise disruption to normal school operations during construction?

School Infrastructure NSW (SINSW) works closely with the principal and staff to ensure that school operations continue with minimal disruption.
