Main construction works complete

The works at Ajuga, Campbell House and Glenfield Park schools are complete with students and staff expected to occupy the new learning spaces and shared hall from Day 1 Term 1 2021.

The upgrade across the three schools included:

- 15 new permanent learning spaces – five for each school
- six new life skills spaces – two for each school
- practical activity spaces for each of the three schools
- a new multi-purpose hall and associated fitness centre to be shared by all three schools
- upgraded amenities for the shared pool at Glenfield Park School.

The Hilltop Community of Schools Principals are excited to move into the new learning spaces at Ajuga, Campbell House and Glenfield Park schools in 2021.

The design of the new Learning Spaces provides our teachers with the opportunity to focus on targeted learning in the classroom setting. Additionally, the designated wellbeing spaces offer the chance for students and staff to practise and embed our trauma-responsive education approach.

The new practical learning areas, available in all three schools, have been designed for our students undertaking Hospitality, Music, Art and Design and Technology core and elective subjects. These spaces are fitted with tailored equipment which will enrich the learning experience for our students. The spaces are a critical link to further vocational pathways for students.

Our staff are looking forward to utilising our enhanced learning environments which will lead to the strengthened development and implementation of innovative curriculum.

As a community of schools, Ajuga, Campbell House and Glenfield Park will also have shared spaces that will connect our communities and enable professional learning opportunities. With a shared assembly room, gymnasium, educational School Psychologist office and meetings room, we envisage shared ideas and professional dialogue that will support all of our staff in sharing best practice.

We look forward to sharing and showcasing our new buildings to our school community.

Innovation and sustainability in design

The new, innovative learning environments offer flexibility in lesson planning and classroom management for staff; and provide opportunities for students to work in groups. The spaces are adaptable to changing classroom dynamics too, fitted with indoor and outdoor breakout areas available in each learning space.

The multipurpose hall will become a shared space between the three schools, allowing for coordinated learning, activities and events to take place with students and staff across all schools.

The project has incorporated sustainability principles into the design and build including coloured concrete finishes to reduce ground heat and solar panel installation on the roof of the Ajuga School. The installation of solar panels is part of the NSW Government's approach for reducing emissions. Ajuga School will take advantage of solar panels to provide electricity to the new teaching spaces.

Frequently asked questions

Will there be any changes to the school entrances?

The existing school entrances have remained.

Are there any sustainability features as part of this upgrade?

The project has installed solar panels and coloured concrete finishes to reduce ground floor heat. Rain water tanks have also been installed to collect water from the roofs of the new buildings.

Are the upgraded facilities air conditioned?

Yes, all learning and practical spaces as well as the new hall have air conditioning installed.
