

Investing in our schools

The NSW Government is investing \$6.7 billion over four years to deliver more than 190 new and upgraded schools to support communities across NSW. This is the largest investment in public education infrastructure in the history of NSW.

The NSW Department of Education is committed to delivering new and upgraded schools for communities across NSW. The delivery of these important projects is essential to the future learning needs of our students and supports growth in the local economy.

Planning for a new Performing Arts and Learning Centre at Glenmore Park High School

We are currently undertaking planning for a new Performing Arts and Learning Centre at Glenmore Park High School. A master plan and concept design have been developed and will be shared with the community later this year.

To cater for Glenmore Park High School's strong creative and performing arts focus, the centre aims to deliver 2 flexible learning spaces, a performance hall with seating capacity of over 400, raised stage area with back-of-house holding rooms, change rooms and stores.

The centre will enable the school to hold performances, assemblies and other events and could also be used by neighbouring schools in the area.

Progress summary

Funding for the planning phase of the project was approved in mid-2019 by the NSW Government. This funding allowed early planning works to commence enabling an understanding of the requirements of the school.

Early planning typically involves the development of a business case, design development and site investigations.

Schematic design and the tender process to construct the new Performing Arts and Learning Centre is expected to start later this year. We expect construction to start in early 2021 with the aim of completing the hall in late 2021, subject to planning approvals.

How can I get involved?

We are committed to working together with our school communities and other stakeholders to deliver the best possible learning facilities for students.

The project team will work closely with representatives of the Glenmore Park High School community, including a P&C representative, as part of the Project Reference Group (PRG). This group will meet monthly to review further design development and monitor progress of the project.
