

Glenroi Heights Public School

Works notification | 17 February 2026

Dear parents, staff and carers,

As part of the new [Administration and Library Building project](#) at Glenroi Heights Public School, the existing covered walkway next to Building G will be removed to facilitate the construction work. These activities form part of the ongoing remediation works previously communicated on [30 January 2026](#).

The partial eave lining of the old walkway is known to contain bonded asbestos as listed on the School Asbestos Management Plan. The small portion of the eave lining will be removed as part of the project. Removal will take place on Thursday 19 February 2026 outside of school hours. The area is already fenced off as part of the construction zone.

NSW Health explains the “living or working with asbestos, or just being around it, is a low risk to your health as long as the asbestos is in good condition and not damaged”.

All work will be done in accordance with work health and safety laws and the NSW Department of Education’s Asbestos Management Plan. Safety measures, including temporary fencing, signage and workers wearing personal protective equipment, will be in place while work is being done. All work will be completed by licensed asbestos contractors and inspected by independent hygienists, who will provide clearance before the walkway is reopened for use.

The health, safety and wellbeing of the school and the local community is our highest priority.
