

Glenroi Heights Public School

Works notification | 30 January 2026

Dear staff, parents and carers,

The health, safety and wellbeing of the school and the local community is our highest priority.

As part of the [new administration and library building project](#) at Glenroi Heights Public School, we will be removing the existing covered walkway next to the new construction site at Building G.

The partial eave linings of the old walkway are known to contain bonded asbestos as listed on the School Asbestos Management Plan. These eave linings will be removed as part of the project. Removal will take place on Saturday 7 February 2026. The area is already fenced off as part of the construction zone.

NSW Health explains the “living or working with asbestos, or just being around it, is a low risk to your health as long as the asbestos is in good condition and not damaged”.

All work will be done in accordance with work health and safety laws and the NSW Department of Education’s Asbestos Management Plan. Safety measures, including temporary fencing, signage and workers wearing personal protective equipment, will be in place while work is being done. All work will be completed by licensed asbestos contractors and inspected by independent hygienists, who will provide clearance before the rooms are reopened for use.
