Project overview

A project to upgrade Glenwood High School is underway to provide improved education facilities to support the growing student community. Subject to development consent, we will:

- Build a new three storey building, which will include 47 learning spaces
- Refurbish the ground floors of Blocks A and D
- Refurbish Blocks E and J
- Landscape the site.

Progress summary

- Our architects and planners are on track to finalise the schematic design of the upgrade by late 2021.
- We have started to relocate the temporary classrooms from the future construction area and are scheduled to complete this by early 2022.
- A Development Application (DA-21-02007), which covers site establishment, enabling works, and earthworks, was lodged with Blacktown City Council on 10 November 2021
- An Environmental Impact Assessment (EIS) has been prepared and the State Significant Development (SSD) application lodged with the Department of Planning, Industry and Environment (DPIE) on Monday, 15 November. The SSD application covers construction of the new three storey building and refurbishment of existing blocks. It will be publicly exhibited for a period of 28 days from 19 November 2021.
