New public school at Googong

A project is underway to deliver a new primary school for the Googong community. The school will include flexible learning spaces, a library, hall, canteen, special program unit, covered outdoor learning area and Administration and Staff facilities. These new facilities will cater for up to 700 students with construction completion expected in early 2023.

Early investigation work is underway on site for the new primary school at Googong

From Tuesday 4 May to Friday 7 May, our crews will be conducting bore hole testing on the site planned for the new primary school in Googong on Gorman Drive. We will use a truck-mounted drill rig to make these bore holes, which is roughly as loud as a commercial lawnmower. An excavator will also be used onsite, and will not traverse any public land. The excavator will be operated by a qualified contractor, and will be accompanied by a safety officer.

Test areas will be cordoned off during drilling to ensure the safety of the community. There will be no traffic impacts as a result of this work.

Over the coming months, our project team and contractors, such as architects and engineers, will be conducting a range of investigations at the Gorman Drive site as part of their early construction planning.

Hours of construction

Standard project working hours are 7:00am to 5:00pm, Monday to Friday and 8:00am to 1:00pm Saturday. No work will take place on Sundays or public holidays.
