Investing in our schools

As part of the NSW Government's plan to rebuild public education, the 2025-26 Budget is delivering \$3.9 billion for new and upgraded schools in Western Sydney. This targeted investment will ensure growing communities get access to a world class public education.

Project overview

The upgrade to Greenway Park Public School will deliver 8 new permanent classrooms to replace the demountable classrooms at the school. Additionally, a new public preschool will be built on the school grounds connecting the preschool with the primary school. This connection will simplify drop off and pick-ups for those who have children at both locations. The preschool will have capacity to accommodate up to 60 children per day and include 3 preschool rooms, an outside play area, administration area, staff kitchen, storage and amenities. Progress summary

In Term 1, we installed 5 new temporary demountable classrooms to accommodate students during the upgrade. Students are currently utilising these classrooms. These will be removed once the upgrade is complete. We have also removed older demountable classrooms to make way for the new classroom building to be built.

Plans on exhibition

The planning application, known as a Review of Environmental Factors (REF), for the Greenway Park Public School upgrade is now on public exhibition on the NSW Planning Portal for Division 5.1 (Part 5) Activities until **Sunday 13 July 2025.**

Next steps

We anticipate that the successful construction contractor will be awarded by late July 2025.

When the exhibition period for the REF ends, any responses will be reviewed and considered as part of the REF process. The REF will be assessed by the department's Planning Assessment team who will determine the outcome of the proposal. We expect to receive planning determination by mid-September 2025.

Further information about the timeline and next steps in construction will be shared once the outcome of the REF proposal is known, and the construction contractor is confirmed.

Frequently asked questions

When will construction of the new classrooms and preschool buildings be completed?

The new classrooms and preschool buildings are expected to be completed by late 2026, with staff and students moving into the new facilities by/on Day 1 Term 1 2027.

How many classrooms will be built?

The project will deliver 8 new permanent classrooms to replace the demountable classrooms at the school.

When will the preschool open?

The opening date of the preschool will be communicated after service approval is complete.

How many children will the preschool accommodate?

The new public preschool at Greenway Park PS will accommodate up to 60 children per day.

At what age can children attend Greenway Park preschool?

Children can enrol in preschool from the beginning of the school year if they turn 4 years of age on or before 31 July that year.

How can families enrol children at Greenway Park Public Preschool?

The school will communicate with the community when enrolment applications can be taken, which is expected to be approximately 6 months before the preschool opening date.
