### **Investing in our schools**

The NSW Government is investing \$6 billion over the next four years to deliver more than 170 new and upgraded schools to support communities across NSW. In addition, a record \$847 million is being spent on school maintenance over four years. This is the largest investment in public education infrastructure in the history of NSW.

### **Upgrade of Greenwich Public School**

A project is being planned for both the Kingslangley Road and Greenwich Road campuses of Greenwich Public School. The project will deliver flexible learning spaces for 670 students by 2020.

The Kingslangley Road campus upgrade will include 18 new permanent teaching spaces, a new library, two existing permanent teaching spaces converted to special programs rooms, and an upgrade to core facilities including the canteen, staff and administration amenities and the hall.

The Greenwich Road campus upgrade will include 8 new permanent teaching spaces, two existing teaching spaces converted to special programs rooms and an upgrade to the existing administration building.

### **Progress summary**

Lane Cove Council have concluded assessment of the Development Application and approval for both sites was received on 14 November 2018. The contract for design and construction has been awarded to Taylor Construction Group (TCG). Site establishment works are being undertaken and the finalisation of the detailed design is ongoing.

### **Summer school holiday works**

Some preparatory construction works will be undertaken during the Summer school holidays to enable major construction to commence in early 2019. These works will include:

#### **Kingslangley Road campus**

- Continue site establishment works
- Deliver up to four demountable classrooms from the Greenwich Road campus to the Kingslangley Road campus.
- Commence demolition of the tennis courts.

#### **Greenwich Road campus**

- Continue site establishment works
- Install temporary pedestrian pathway
- Commence installation of stormwater tank.

## Frequently asked questions

### What are the construction working hours?

Construction hours over the Summer break will be as per the standard hours:

- Monday to Friday, 7am to 5:30pm
- Saturday, 7am to 4pm.

No work is to be undertaken on Sunday or on public holidays.

### Will construction take place over Christmas and New Year?

Limited construction works will continue through the Christmas and New Year period (public holidays excluded).

### How will this work affect the school's Share Our Space arrangements?

Where Share Our Space arrangements are impacted by construction works, the School will provide notice of alternative arrangements.

### What safety measures will be in place?

The health and safety of the community is our highest priority.

Temporary fencing has been erected around the construction site to secure the area and prevent public access.

### What steps will be taken to control noise and dust impacts?

Noise and dust control measures will be implemented in accordance with planning approval requirements.

Hoarding and shade cloth have been erected to reduce noise and dust impacts on the school and local residents.

Dust from construction works will be hosed down as required.

### How will traffic be managed?

Traffic management will be in place where required for the safety of students, staff, the local community and workers.

Traffic controllers will be used where required to manage entry and exit of vehicles to and from the construction site.

Vehicles will give way to pedestrians at all times.

### How will you keep us informed during construction?

School infrastructure NSW will continue to share construction updates and project information as the project progresses. We will provide information through information booths, project updates, our website and school newsletters.

### Will there be any changes to pedestrian access, staff parking, play space and other facilities from Day 1, Term 1 2019?

There will be some changes to the school from Day 1, Term 1 2019 to enable construction. These include:

- Temporary pedestrian access detours
- Removal of staff parking on the Greenwich Road campus to enable the construction of a new building
- Temporary closure of part of the school oval and other parts of the playground on the Kingslangley Road campus to allow for the temporary relocation of demountable classrooms from the Greenwich Road campus
- Closure of the tennis courts at the Kingslangley Road campus to enable the construction of new tennis courts.

Signage will be installed to notify the school community of any changes.
