

Greenwich Public School Upgrade

Works notification

18 May 2020

We are upgrading the Kingslangley Road campus of Greenwich Public School.

Crane delivery and oversized truck movements

As part of the upgrade, the demountable classrooms in the southeast corner of the site will be removed from Thursday 21 May (please refer to the map overleaf).

Work activities will include:

- installing temporary fencing around the work area
- disconnecting the demountable modules
- lifting the demountable modules with a 60 tonne mobile crane onto 48 trucks over a three day period from Monday 25 May
- clearing the site.

The mobile crane and trucks will access the work area via the River Road site entrance. Traffic control will be in place for the safety of the school, motorists and the local community. Access will be maintained to all residential properties at all times.

Work hours will be Monday to Friday, 7:00 am to 5:30 pm and Saturday, 7:00 am to 4:00 pm. The work will take approximately 8 days to complete, weather and site conditions permitting.

In the event of bad weather the crane works will be cancelled and rescheduled. Further notification will be provided.
