Investing in our schools

The NSW Government is investing \$6.7 billion over the next four years to deliver 190 new and upgraded schools to support communities across NSW. In addition, a record \$1.3 billion is being spent on school maintenance over five years. This is the largest investment in public education infrastructure in the history of NSW.

Greenwich Public School

A project is underway to upgrade the Kingslangley Road and Greenwich Road campuses of Greenwich Public School. The project will deliver flexible learning spaces for 670 students.

The Kingslangley Road campus upgrade will deliver 18 new permanent teaching spaces, a new library, two special programs rooms, and an upgrade to the canteen, staff and administration amenities and the hall.

The Greenwich Road campus upgrade will deliver eight new permanent teaching spaces.

Progress summary

Main construction is well underway. At the Greenwich Road campus, the building has been completed and fitout is nearing completion. At the Kinglslangley Road campus, the concrete structure has been completed and roofing works have commenced.

Next Steps

As work progresses on the Kingslangley Road campus, Kindergarten to Year 2 will be occupying the Greenwich Road campus from Term 1, 2020. Year 3 to 6 students will continue to occupy demountables at the Kingslangley Road campus as work progresses on the site. We will provide more information about the Kingslangley Road campus before the end of term.
