Works update

Removal of asbestos containing material at Greystanes Public School

In addition to our notification of December 2018, tests have confirmed that further bonded asbestos containing material (asbestos that is not air borne) has been found at Greystanes Public School.

Asbestos is managed in accordance with the Department of Education's Asbestos Management Plan and Safe Work NSW by licensed and accredited asbestos removalists and occupational hygienists in strict accordance with all applicable legislation, regulations, policies and guidelines. A remediation plan has been developed and appropriate safety measures was implemented prior to removal.

This work has been ongoing and is anticipated to be completed before Day 1 Term 2 (Monday 29 April), weather permitting. No asbestos containing material would be removed during school hours, with work only taking place after school hours on school days, on weekends and over the term break within the approved working hours of 7am-6pm Monday-Friday and 8am-1pm on Saturdays. Please be aware that removal of asbestos containing material will pose no risk to staff, students or the local community.

The health, safety and wellbeing of students, staff and neighbours is our highest priority. Air monitoring and site fencing will remain in place until further notice and we will continue to keep the community updated as more information becomes available.
