Works notification

Confirmed finding of contaminated material at Greystanes Public School

Tests have confirmed that some material found at the Greystanes Public School upgrade site is bonded Asbestos (Asbestos that is not air borne). Asbestos is managed in accordance with the Department of Education's Asbestos Management Plan and Safe Work NSW by licensed and accredited asbestos removalists and occupational hygienists in strict accordance with all applicable legislation, regulations, policies and guidelines.

The site is now under construction. Appropriate safety measures will be implemented prior to removal. A remediation plan has been developed and removal of the contaminated material is planned to start from late December 2018. This work is anticipated to be completed by early January 2019 during the school holiday break. Please be aware that removal of asbestos will not pose a risk to the local community.

The health, safety and well-being of students, staff and neighbours is our highest priority. Air monitoring and site fencing will remain in place until further notice and we will continue to keep the community updated as more information becomes available.
