Investing in our schools

The NSW Government is investing \$6.7 billion over four years to deliver more than 190 new and upgraded schools to support communities across NSW. In addition, a record \$1.3 billion is being spent on school maintenance over five years. This is the largest investment in public education infrastructure in the history of NSW.

The NSW Department of Education is committed to delivering new and upgraded schools for communities across NSW. The delivery of these important projects is essential to the future learning needs of our students and supports growth in the local economy.

Greystanes Public School

A project is underway to upgrade Greystanes Public School. The project will deliver:

- 24 new permanent learning spaces
- refurbishment of the administration block into a multi-purpose space
- a new administration building.

Progress summary

The Covered Outdoor Learning Area (COLA) building work is nearing completion. In-ground service installation is in progress.

The ground and first floor slabs in the new Block M North Wing are in place. Structural steel installation is finished, with roof installation underway. The onsite detention tank is also finished.

Next steps

- Completion of the new COLA building structure.
- Block M North Wing Building: Completion of the roof. Commencement of internal fit-out of the building.
- Block M South Wing Building: Commencement of earthworks.
