Investing in our schools

The NSW Government is investing \$6.7 billion over four years to deliver more than 190 new and upgraded schools to support communities across NSW. In addition, a record \$1.3 billion is being spent on school maintenance over five years. This is the largest investment in public education infrastructure in the history of NSW.

The NSW Department of Education is committed to delivering new and upgraded schools for communities across NSW. The delivery of these important projects is essential to the future learning needs of our students and supports growth in the local economy.

Progress summary

The covered outdoor learning area (COLA) structural steel and inground services installation is in progress. Roof sheeting will follow shortly after. Ground floor slab for the new building Block M north wing has been completed.

School holiday works

Over the break, we will be excavating and installing the onsite detention tank (OSD) and removing part of the existing covered walkway awning outside of the hoarding. We will also be digging a trench between the work areas to connect services.

Block M South Wing will have the forming of the first floor slab.

What are the construction working hours?

Construction hours over the Term 2 holiday will be as per the existing approved hours. 7:00am to 6:00pm Monday to Friday and 8:00am to 1:00pm on Saturdays. No work will take place on Sundays.

What safety measures will be in place?

The health and safety of the community is our highest priority. Site fencing has been erected around the construction site to secure the area and prevent public access / school access.

What steps will be taken to control noise and dust impacts?

Noise and dust control measures will be implemented in accordance with planning approval requirements. Temporary fencing with shade cloth has been erected to reduce dust impacts on the school. The site, dust from construction works and trucks will be regularly hosed down as required, to minimise dust, pending water-use restrictions.
