The NSW Department of Education is committed to delivering new and upgraded schools for communities across NSW. The delivery of these important projects is essential to the future learning needs of our students and supports growth in the local economy.

Project overview

A project is underway to upgrade Greystanes Public School. The project will deliver:

- 24 new permanent learning spaces (Block M North and South Wings)
- refurbishment of the administration block into a multi-purpose space
- a new administration building (Block L).

Progress summary

The new Covered Outdoor Learning Area (COLA) shelter has been completed and will be handed over for the school to use after completion of the new Administration building (Block L).

Construction works for Block M North Wing have been completed. The building will be ready for use by staff and students when the Block M South Wing is completed in late 2021.

Bulk earthworks have been completed for the Block M South Wing with some of the ground slabs completed.

Next steps

- Complete all ground slabs and retaining walls for Block M South wing.
- Completion of internal services installation and wall / ceiling construction for Block L.

The project is anticipated to be completed late 2021.
