Gulyangarri Public School

Project update | June 2023

A new primary school in Liverpool

We are building a new public school in Liverpool on the grounds of the existing Liverpool Boys and Girls High Schools. Following consultation with the local community and stakeholders, the new school has been named Gulyangarri Public School.

When complete, Gulyangarri Public School will cater for current and projected enrolment growth. The school is being delivered in two phases.

The first phase of the project will deliver a primary school for 640 students with:

- 20 teaching spaces
- 4 special education teaching spaces
- 4 special programs rooms
- A hall, library and covered outdoor learning area (COLA)
- A preschool building for up to 40 children.

This phase is expected to be operational in 2024.

To accommodate enrolment up to 1200 students, future stages would include up to 24 additional teaching spaces. The full scale and timing of the second phase of the project is subject to current and ongoing demand within the broader Liverpool area.

Enrolments are now open

Due to the opening of the new Gulyangarri Public School, the school intake areas of Liverpool Public School, Marsden Road Public School and Warwick Farm Public School have been adjusted. Progress summary

In order to meet the SSD conditions of consent, School Infrastructure NSW (SINSW) has been working with the local health district regarding the use of Burnside Drive for the commencement of construction works at site. This had an impact on the overall project timeline.

Construction on Gulyangarri Public School started on Monday 30 January 2023. Piling works for the foundation of the new buildings and site remediation works are now complete. Over the next few weeks, we expect the following work to take place:

- Concrete pours to lay the foundations of buildings X and Y which will house the new hall, covered outdoor learning area (COLA), library and learning spaces
- Lightweight framing works will begin in June, followed by external façade, pavement and landscaping works
- Internal fit out services such as light fittings, door hardware, locks etc.

Modifications to the SSD

Following consultations with NSW Health, we proposed changes to conditions regarding the timing and use of Burnside Drive and the construction of a new internal road at Lachlan Street to deliver works. These proposed changes have been submitted to the Department of Planning and Environment (DPE) as modifications 1 and 2 to the approved State Significant Development (SSD) application.

- Modification 1 received approval in November 2022, allowing construction to begin. A temporary driveway at Lachlan Street has been created to assist with the safe movement of vehicles into the construction site.
- Modification 2 is under assessment, and we are continuing to work with stakeholders to reach the proposed outcome.
