

Gulyangarri Public School

Works notification | 1 June 2023

We are building a new public school in Liverpool on the grounds of the existing Liverpool Boys and Girls High Schools. The new school has been named Gulyangarri Public School and has received State Significant Development (SSD) approval from the Department of Planning and Environment (DPE).

Upcoming works

On Thursday 8 June, lightweight framing works will begin on level 2 of Building Y, weather permitting. A lightweight frame is like a skeleton to which exterior wall claddings, internal linings, flooring, roofing, doors and windows are attached. Once complete, works will start on Building X. These works are expected to take a few weeks to complete.

During this work, there will be approximately 20 trucks entering and exiting the site to assist with the delivery of materials. Construction vehicles will enter and exit the site via Lachlan Street. Traffic control will be in place to manage trucks onto the site and prioritise pedestrian safety.

Working hours are Monday to Friday, 7 am to 6 pm and Saturday 8 am to 1 pm. No work will occur on Sundays or public holidays, unless otherwise advised. We are here to make sure that work is completed safely and efficiently, and impacts on the community are minimised at every opportunity. Thank you for your patience while we deliver this important school infrastructure.
