

New Public School in Liverpool

Works notification | 21 February 2023

We are building a new public school in Liverpool on the grounds of the existing Liverpool Boys and Girls High Schools. The New Public School in Liverpool project has received State Significant Development (SSD) approval from the Department of Planning and Environment (DPE) and the main works on site commenced on 30 January.

Upcoming Tree Removal

On Tuesday, 28 February 2023, a small number of trees will be removed from the works zone by arborists, weather permitting. *See map below.*

This work will take place using a cherry picker to safely remove upper branches and a woodchipper to transport the trees from the site. The area will be cordoned off from staff and students during the works.

The Department of Planning and Environment approved the removal of the trees as part of the project's State Significant Development (SSD) application to enable the construction of the school's new buildings.

All tree work will be carried out by a suitably qualified arborist and in accordance with SafeWork NSW regulations, Education's Tree Management Plan and the Aboriginal Heritage Impact Permit. Towards completion of the project, replanting will occur as part of landscaping works.

All work will be completed in strict accordance with all applicable legislation, regulations, policies and guidelines. The health, safety, and wellbeing of the school and the local community is our highest priority.

Working hours are Monday to Friday, 7 am to 6 pm and Saturday 8 am to 1 pm. No work will occur on Sundays or public holidays, unless otherwise advised. We are here to make sure that work is completed safely and efficiently and we will minimise impacts on the community at every opportunity.

Thank you for your patience while we deliver this important school infrastructure.
