

Gulyangarri Public School

Works notification | 24 March 2023

We are building a new public school in Liverpool on the grounds of the existing Liverpool Boys and Girls High Schools. The new school has been named Gulyangarri Public School and has received State Significant Development (SSD) approval from the Department of Planning and Environment (DPE). The main works on site commenced on 30 January.

Upcoming Works

We will be pouring concrete to construct a large portion of the slab for the foundation of the new school buildings. This work will start on Friday 31 March 2023, weather permitting and continue for most of the month in April.

During this work, there will be an increased number of trucks entering and exiting the site to maintain the supply of concrete. Traffic control will be in place to manage trucks onto the site and prioritise pedestrian safety.

Working hours are Monday to Friday, 7 am to 6 pm and Saturday 8 am to 1 pm. No work will occur on Sundays or public holidays, unless otherwise advised. We are here to make sure that work is completed safely and efficiently, and impacts on the community are minimised at every opportunity.

Thank you for your patience while we deliver this important school infrastructure.
