

Gulyangarri Public School

Works notification | 4 May 2023

We are building a new public school in Liverpool on the grounds of the existing Liverpool Boys and Girls High Schools. The new school has been named Gulyangarri Public School and has received State Significant Development (SSD) approval from the Department of Planning and Environment (DPE).

Upcoming works

Concrete pours for Building Y level 1 will start on 11 May 2023 and take a few weeks to complete, weather permitting. Concrete pours for Building Y level 2 is expected to start on 6 June 2023 and will take a few weeks to complete, weather permitting.

During this work, there will be an increased number of trucks entering and exiting the site to maintain the supply of concrete. Construction vehicles will enter and exit the site via Lachlan Street (see image overleaf). Traffic control will be in place to manage trucks onto the site and prioritise pedestrian safety.

Working hours are Monday to Friday, 7 am to 6 pm and Saturday 8 am to 1 pm. No work will occur on Sundays or public holidays, unless otherwise advised. We are here to make sure that work is completed safely and efficiently, and impacts on the community are minimised at every opportunity.

Thank you for your patience while we deliver this important school infrastructure.

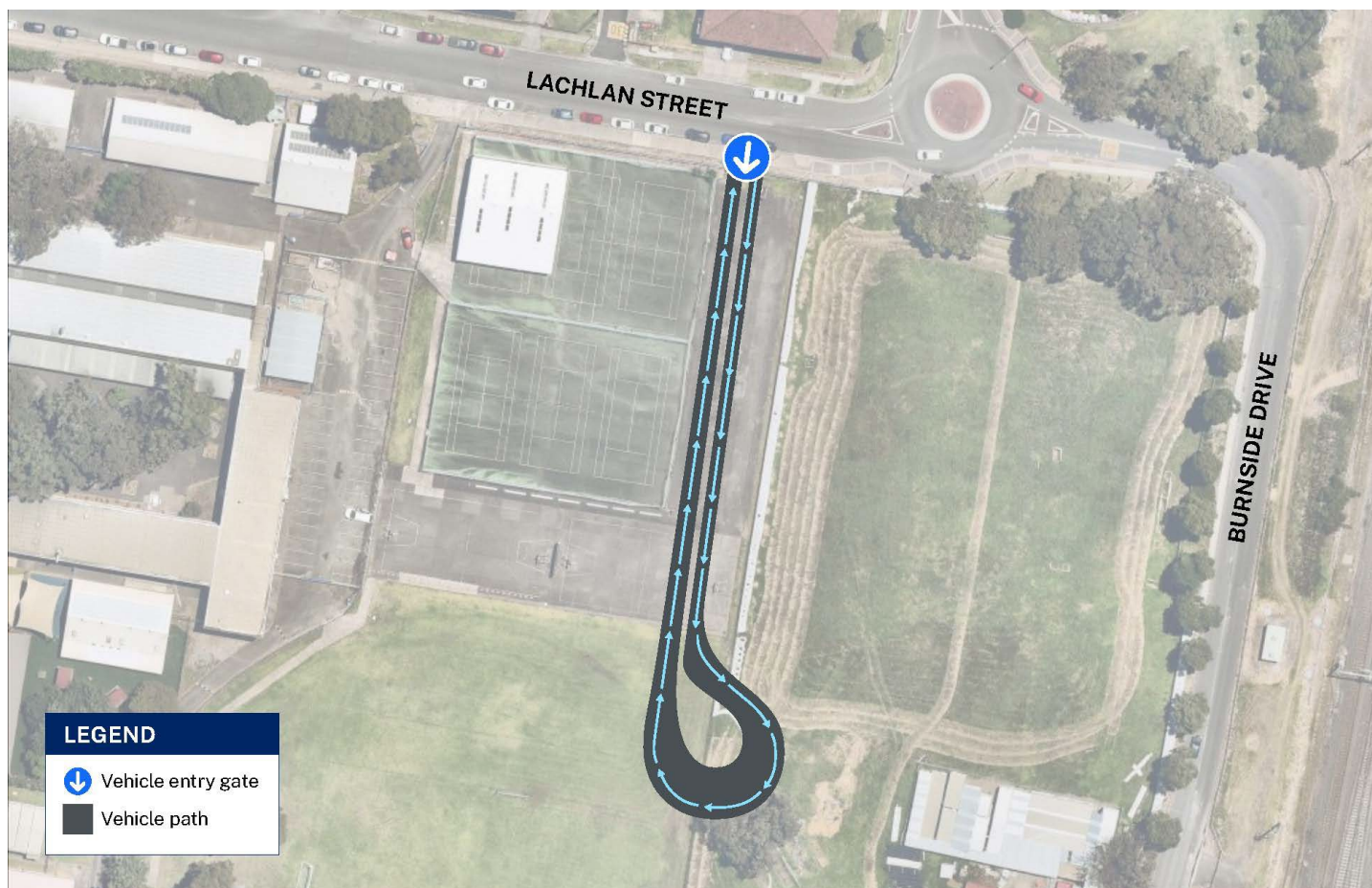


Image: Entry and exit route for construction vehicles via Lachlan Street
