

Gulyangarri Public School

Works notification | 10 November 2023

We are delivering a package of public domain improvement works for Gulyangarri Public School that will assist students, school staff and visitors to access the new school buildings safely, as well as improve the amenity in the local area. The safety of students, school staff and the local community is the highest priority.

The Public Domain Design has been developed in collaboration with Liverpool Council and Transport for NSW (TfNSW) as the Authority Regulator.

Public domain improvements

Public domain improvement works will start from Monday 13 November, weather permitting and include:

- extension of the existing median island on the eastern end of Lachlan Street
- installation of a children’s crossing on Lachlan Street, between Drummond Street and Lachlan Lane
- installation of a pedestrian refuge on Drummond Street at the Lachlan Street intersection
- installation of line marking, and signage associated with the above improvements.

See the map overleaf for the location of these works. We anticipate these works will be finished in January 2024.

When the school is operational in January 2024, a crossing supervisor will be appointed to manage the children’s crossing for traffic and pedestrian movement during the pickup and drop off times. Residents on 20 Drummond Street and staff at Liverpool Boys and Girls High Schools are requested to avoid using their driveways during peak school hours in the morning and afternoon.

Traffic, parking and access changes

During the improvement works, there will be temporary changes to pedestrian and vehicle movements along Lachlan Street and Drummond Street.

Where required, traffic control measures will be in place to ensure the safe movement of pedestrians and vehicles. Access to properties and driveways will be maintained.

Working hours are Monday to Friday, 7 am to 6 pm and Saturday 8 am to 1 pm. Some out of hours work may take place on Saturday between 7 am to 6 pm if required. This work is not expected to be noisy. We are here to make sure that work is completed safely and efficiently and impacts on the community are minimised at every opportunity.
