Investing in our schools

The NSW Government is investing \$6.7 billion over four years to deliver more than 190 new and upgraded schools to support communities across NSW. This is the largest investment in public education infrastructure in the history of NSW.

The NSW Department of Education is committed to delivering new and upgraded schools for communities across NSW. The delivery of these important projects is essential to the future learning needs of our students and supports growth in the local economy.

New public school in Googong

An announcement has been made to build a new primary school in Googong. The project will deliver:

- over 33 permanent learning spaces, including special programs rooms
- core facilities including the school canteen, hall, administration and staff facilities and
- a covered outdoor learning area (COLA).

The project is being fast-tracked as part of the NSW Government's \$3 billion Jobs and Infrastructure Acceleration fund.

The new primary school will accommodate over 700 students and all new classrooms will be air conditioned.

The school will be located on Gorman Drive between McPhail Way and Wilkins Way.

Project staging

The business case has been lodged and we will be calling for contractors by the end of 2020.

A detailed timeline for delivery will be confirmed as planning progresses.
