Investing in our schools

The NSW Government is investing \$6.7 billion over the next four years to deliver 190 new and upgraded schools to support communities across NSW. In addition, a record \$1.3 billion is being spent on school maintenance over five years. This is the largest investment in public education infrastructure in the history of NSW.

Harrington Park Public School

A project is underway to upgrade Harrington Park Public School. This upgrade includes 19 new permanent innovative learning spaces, new staff and administration facilities, a new covered outdoor learning area (COLA) and an upgrade to the school hall and library.

Progress summary

Phase One, which involves the construction of the new car park, is nearing completion. We will go to tender to appoint a construction contractor for Phase Two works next month.

Phase Two works include the construction of the new administration facilities, library, school hall and COLA . These works are anticipated to commence by late 2019.

We continue to work closely with the school to deliver this exciting upgrade and will keep you informed throughout the project.
