The NSW Government is investing \$7.9 billion over the next four years, continuing its program to deliver 215 new and upgraded schools to support communities across NSW. This is the largest investment in public education infrastructure in the history of NSW.

The NSW Department of Education is committed to delivering new and upgraded schools for communities across NSW. The delivery of these important projects is essential to the future learning needs of our students and supports growth in the local economy.

Project overview

An upgrade to Harrington Park Public School is underway. The project will deliver 19 new permanent learning spaces, new staff and administrative facilities, library, a new covered outdoor learning area (COLA), and a new hall.

Progress update

Construction of the new hall is on track for handover in early 2022. The new hall has a stage and associated audio visual equipment including two televisions, a projector and speakers. The hall also includes a canteen and outside school hours care (OSHC) facilities.

Other works to date on the Harrington Park Public School upgrade include:

- new staff car park completed
- demolition of Block J
- completion of level 1 of the new Block M learning facility, with the roof now complete and the services and fit out currently in progress
- ongoing landscaping work at Block A.

School holiday works

Construction for the project will shut down for Christmas from 24 to 27 December 2021. In addition, work will not take place on the project on public holidays or on Sundays.

Planned works for the Christmas holidays are as follows:

- demolition of the existing hall
- continuing construction of tiered seating, stairs, and ramps to the central landscape hub
- continue external cladding to Block M (new learning block)
- continue internal fitout to Block M
- commence equipment fitoff to Block K (new hall)
- continue external works to Block K.

There are no roadworks over the Christmas and New Year period. There will be minimal noise and sound impacts from the related activities.
