## Investing in our schools

The NSW Government is investing \$7 billion over the next four years, continuing its program to deliver more than 200 new and upgraded schools to support communities across NSW. This is the largest investment in public education infrastructure in the history of NSW.

The NSW Department of Education is committed to delivering new and upgraded schools for communities across NSW. The delivery of these important projects is essential to the future learning needs of our students and supports growth in the local economy.

## Project overview

A project is underway to upgrade Harrington Park Public School. This upgrade includes 19 new permanent innovative learning spaces, new staff and administration facilities, a new covered outdoor learning area (COLA) and an upgrade to the school hall and library.

## Progress summary

Works have commenced at Harrington Park Public School. As part of the site establishment works to prepare the school for construction, the Contractor has:

- Installed hoardings for the first phase of works,
- Established the site office and worker facilities
- Relocated the classroom from Block J to the demountable buildings
- Prepared for demolition of Block J to start in the school holiday period
- Removed several trees within the work site, in line with development consent.

## Next steps

Work will continue over the summer holidays. The contractors will:

- Demolish Block J
- Start piling after demolition
- Install footings for the new hall and canteen.

Works will take place between 7am and 5pm Mondays to Saturdays. No works will take place on Sundays or public holidays. Please note that the site will be closed from 23 December 2020 to 4 January 2021.

## Frequently asked questions

### What is being delivered?

The upgrade of Harrington Park Public School will deliver 19 new permanent innovative learning spaces, new staff and administration facilities, a new covered outdoor learning area (COLA) and an upgrade to the school hall and library.

### What works will take place over the summer holidays?

Over the school summer holidays, we will demolish Block J, start piling and install footing on the new Hall and canteen.

### What are the construction working hours?

Works will take place between standard construction working hours. These are 7am to 5pm Monday to Saturday. No works will take place on Sundays or public holidays.

### Will construction take place over Christmas and New Year?

The site will be closed from 23 December 2020 to 4 January 2021.

### Will street parking be impacted during construction?

There will be minimal impacts to street parking. The impact of our project on the local community is considered in our planning. We work with council and the community to identify issues and put in place mitigation measures.

### What safety measures will be in place?

The health and safety of the community is our highest priority. Temporary fencing will be erected around the construction site to secure the area and prevent public access. Traffic control measures will be in place where needed.

### What steps will be taken to control noise and dust impacts?

Noise and dust control measures will be implemented in accordance with planning approval requirements. Hoarding, secure fencing and shade cloth have been erected to reduce noise and dust impacts on the school and local residents. Dust from construction works will be hosed down as required.

### How will traffic be managed?

Traffic management will be in place where required for the safety of the local community and workers. Traffic controllers will be used to manage entry and exit of vehicles to and from the construction site as necessary. Traffic Management Plans will be implemented when works are occurring on road frontages. Vehicles will give way to pedestrians at all times.

### How will the community be kept informed?

We will keep the school and local community informed through project notifications, information booths, school newsletters, drop-in sessions and website updates.

We are here to make sure that work is completed safely and efficiently and we will minimise impacts on the community at every opportunity.
