Investing in our schools

The NSW Government is investing \$8.6 billion in school infrastructure over the next four years, continuing its program to deliver 160 new and upgraded schools to support communities across NSW. This builds on the more than \$9.1 billion invested in projects delivered since 2017, a program of \$17.7 billion in public education infrastructure.

The NSW Department of Education is committed to delivering new and upgraded schools for communities across NSW. The delivery of these important projects is essential to the future learning needs of our students and supports growth in the local economy.

Project overview

An upgrade to Harrington Park Public School is underway. The project will deliver 19 new permanent learning spaces, new staff and administrative facilities, a new covered outdoor learning area (COLA), and a new hall and library.

Progress update

Work on the new Building M was completed in time for Day 1 of Term 3. This follows-on from the handover of the new hall (Building K) for the start of Term 1, 2022.

Building M is a new 2-storey learning building. It provides 13 new learning spaces, with audiovisual/interactive boards, 19 toilets, and new tiered seating.

Works on the new administration building (Building L) continue, with lightweight framing being installed to the upper level.

The Building K to M Link walkway is now mostly complete, with minor works to be completed outside of school hours. Work on the Buildings B and C soft fall installation has been affected by inclement weather and will be scheduled to be undertaken in the future. We appreciate the patience of the local community while the upgrade to the Harrington Park Public School is undertaken. There are some necessary restrictions to parts of the site during construction, including for safety, and we endeavour to complete construction in the shortest appropriate timeframe, with minimal disruption.

Removal of temporary classrooms

Work will take place to remove temporary classrooms from the school grounds between Monday 1 and Friday 12 August 2022. In the event of wet weather, works may be postponed.

Furniture removal and dismantling of the temporary classrooms will start on 1 August.

Works will involve setting up a crane on in the Public School carpark to lift the temporary classrooms onto waiting trucks. The crane will arrive on Monday 8 August 2022 and set up for use. Traffic controllers will be in place on the street to manage traffic flow and ensure pedestrian safety throughout the works.

Frequently asked questions

What is being delivered?

The upgrade of Harrington Park Public School will deliver 19 new permanent innovative learning spaces, new staff and administration facilities, a new covered outdoor learning area (COLA) and an upgrade to the school hall and library.

What work is remaining?

- New administration building, Building L.
- Building K to M Link walkway.
- Softfall and landscaping.
- Refurbishment of parts of Buildings A and C to provide more new learning spaces.

What are the construction working hours?

Works will take place between 7 am to 5 pm Monday to Saturday. No works will take place on Sunday or public holidays, unless notified.

How is the community being kept informed?

We will keep the school and local community informed through project notifications, school newsletters and website updates. We are here to make sure that work is completed safely and efficiently and we will minimise impacts on the community at every opportunity.

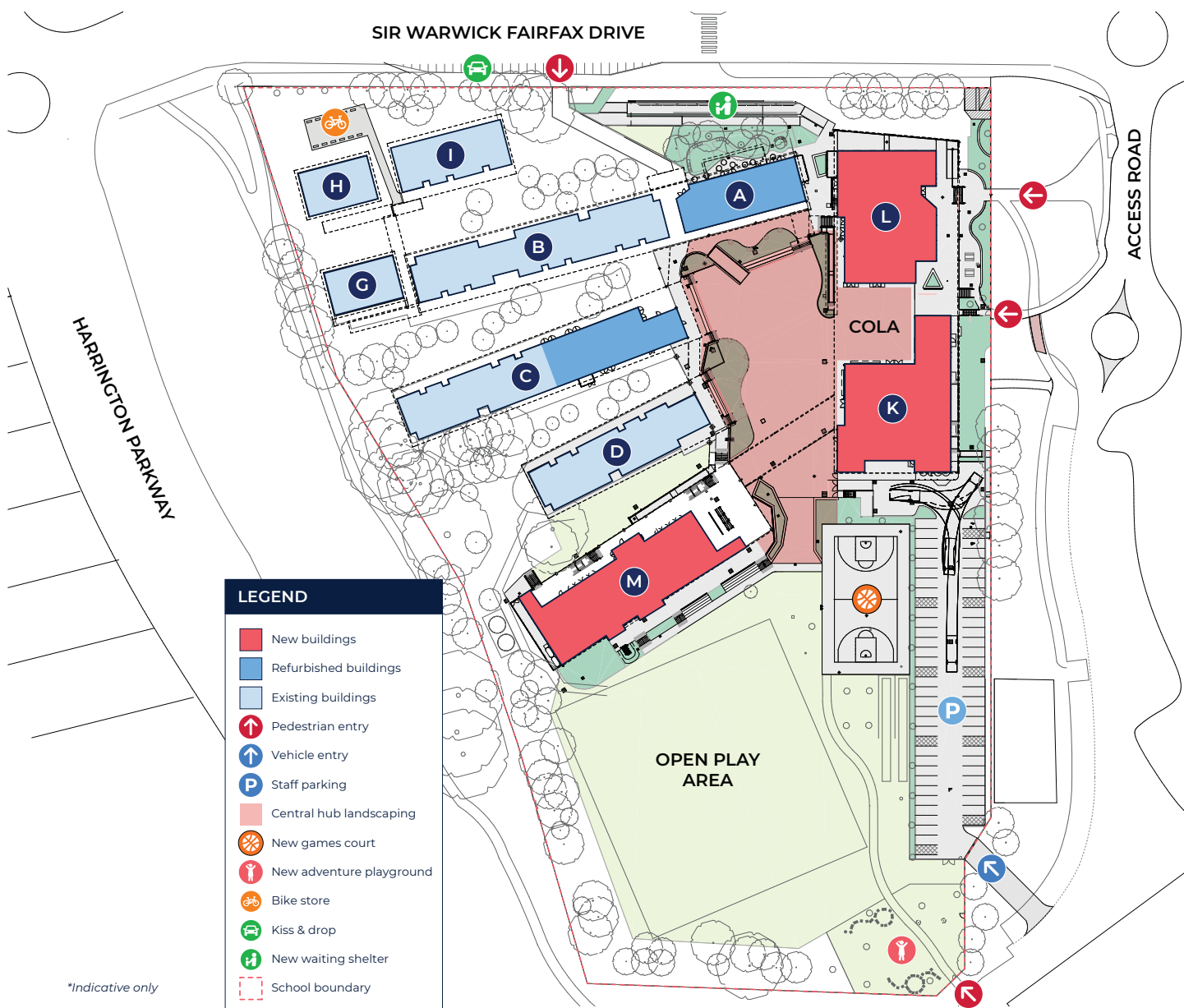
